Thank you for your interest in working for the Redwood Hotel Casino, owned and operated by the Yurok Tribe.

Each applicant will be required to complete a Yurok Tribal Gaming Commission gaming license application.

We want you to be successful in gaining employment with the Redwood Hotel Casino
and being licensed by the Yurok Tribal Gaming Commission.

To assist in completing the gaming license application, please pay special attention to the information below.

Be prepared to have one or more of the following documents in your possession and available to be copied when turning in your gaming application:

- ✓ Certification of Birth
- ✓ Valid driver's license
- ✓ Valid State issued Identification Card
- ✓ Transcript or Certificate of highest level of education
- ✓ Military Identification Card
- ✓ Valid passport, or
- ✓ Alien registration card, if you are a registered alien

Tips to keep in mind when completing your application:

Be Complete - Incomplete, inaccurate information or non-disclosure of certain information will result in a denial of your application.

Be Honest - Do not misstate or omit any material fact(s). Each statement made on the gaming application will be verified.

Read the questions carefully. If you have questions about how to respond to any questions, be certain to discuss those questions with the gaming commission representative who conducts the gaming license intake interview with you.

Initial every page of the application and any additional pages you add.

Initial and date any corrections, changes, or other alterations to your application.

Type or print all answers. Do not use pencil.

Be prepared to provide the following information:

- Ten (10) years of residence (address) history.
- Ten (10) years of employment history. You will need to account for all breaks in employment.
- Five (5) personal references and their current contact information. You may wish to notify your personal references that they may be contacted as part of the background check process.
- Three (3) professional references. These must be professional in nature and do not use any of your five (5) personal references. You may wish to notify your professional references that they may be contacted as part of the background check process.

If approved, you must keep the Gaming Commission apprised of all changes to the information reported on the gaming application.
